




"It was a point during my pregnancy where I thought about getting an abortion," she said. "What saved me was God. He led me to Leslie and Embrace Grace."

Leslie Strange is a member of Judson Baptist Church, Nashville, who was moved by a need to do something for women like Harris.

"I felt something needed to be done to help mothers who decided not to terminate their pregnancy," Strange said. "The heart of Embrace Grace is to ensure young women experiencing an unplanned pregnancy have a church family to go to for spiritual, emotional and physical support."

Harris is thankful Leslie and Judson Baptist Church stepped into her need.

"We all have our struggles," she said. "And a lot of times some moms don't have nobody to turn to and they just give up. Places like this, they'll save your life. I think God works in that way too."
